# Survey Methodology

<i>Period :</i>	October 15-23, 2019
<i>Survey Type :</i>	Computer Assisted Personal Interviews (CAPI)
<i>Eligibility :</i>	Age 18+.
<i>Total Respondents :</i>	n = 2502
<i>Response Rate :</i>	Approximately 65%
<i>Margin of Error :</i>	The margin of error for this poll is estimated at $\pm 2\%$ with a confidence level of 95%.

- A multi-stage probability sample was used. In the first stage, the sample was stratified into four provinces. In the second stage, the sample was further stratified into districts within each province it was divided into rural and urban categories. In the third stage, each district was further stratified by union councils/ Blocks/ Villages.
- The Probability-Proportional-to-Size (PPS) method was used to select localities and household were selected through “Random walk method”. By which starting point was determined and by following the Right Hand Rule (RHR) pattern every nth household were selected for interviews. The Kish Grid was used to select respondents 18 years and older within these randomly selected household.
- The data was collected by using CAPI (Computer Assisted Personal Interview) technique.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding error.

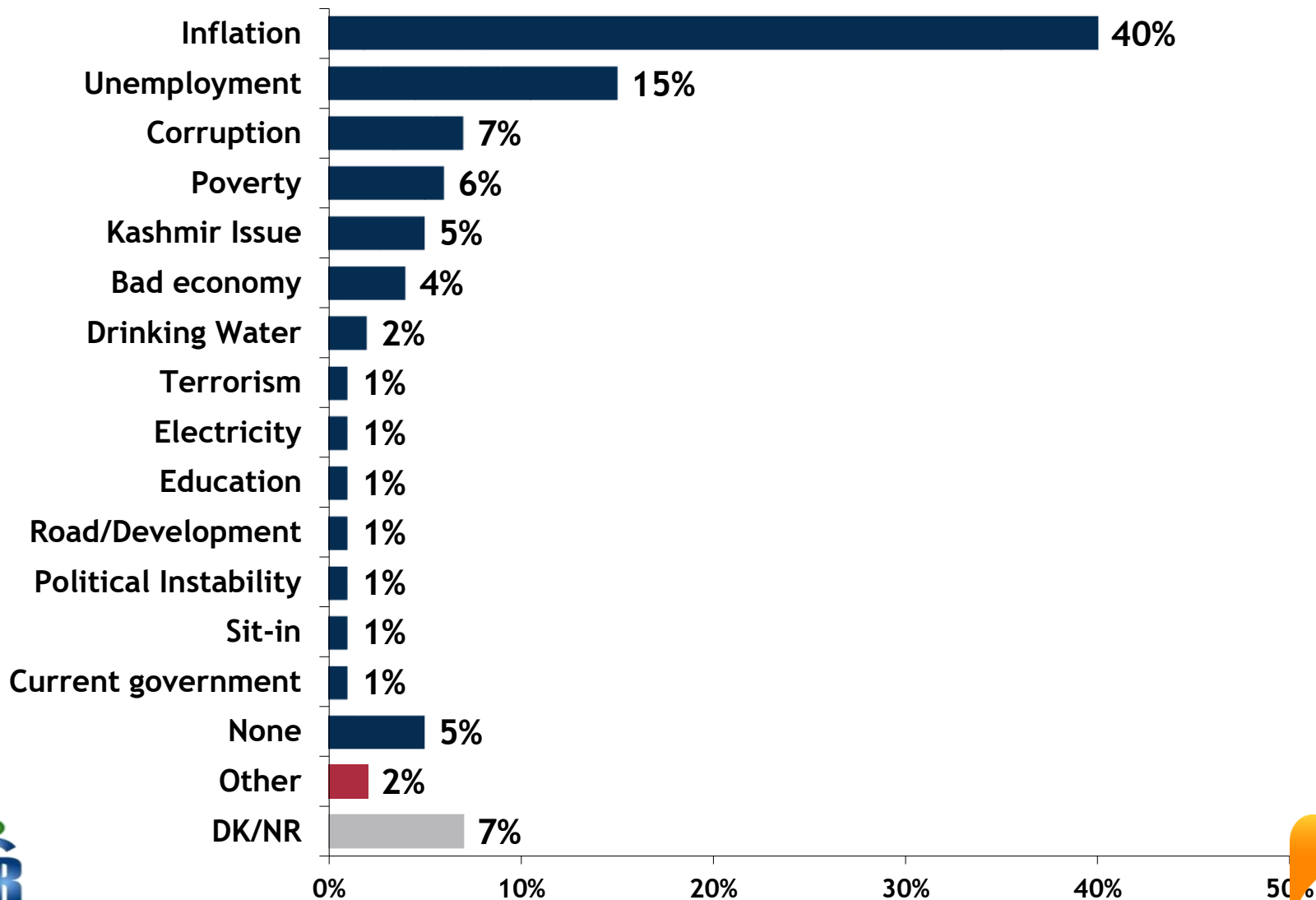

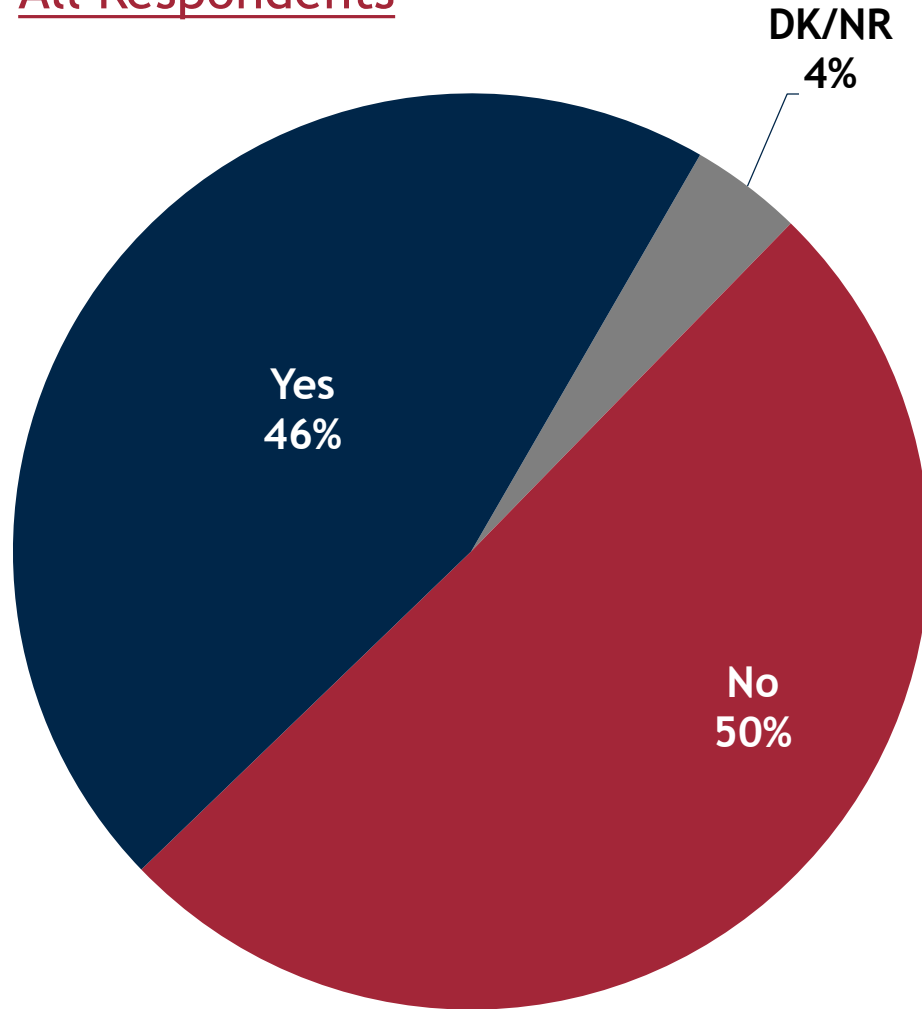
# What is the biggest issue facing Pakistan?

All Respondents



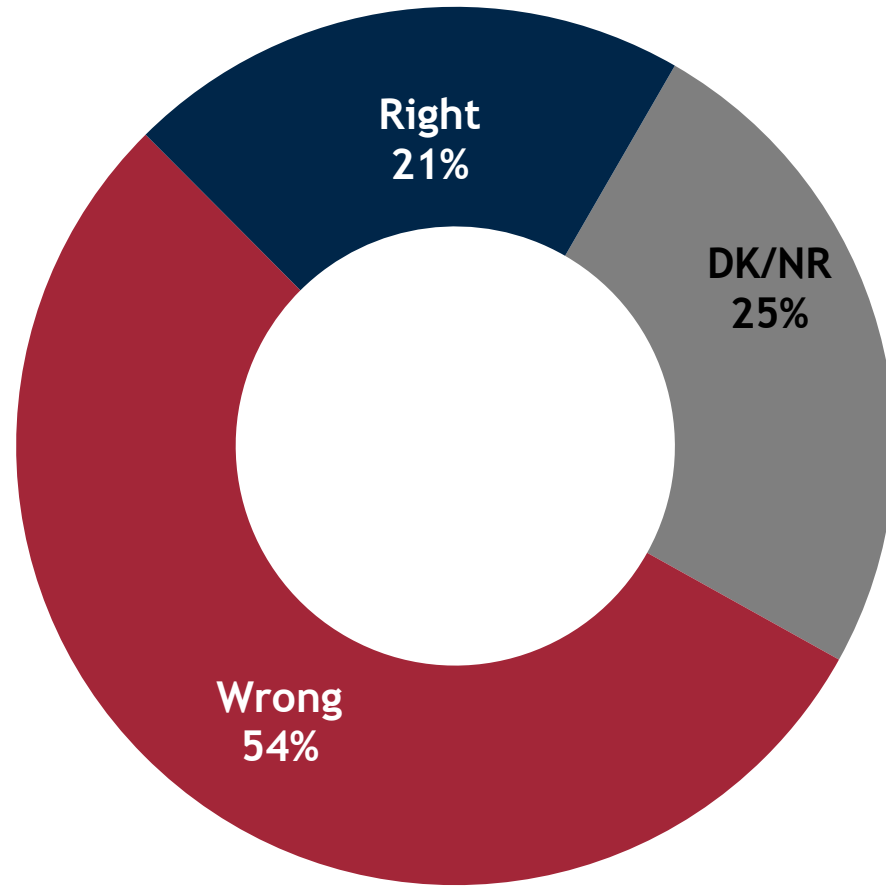
Are you satisfied with the performance of current PTI's government?

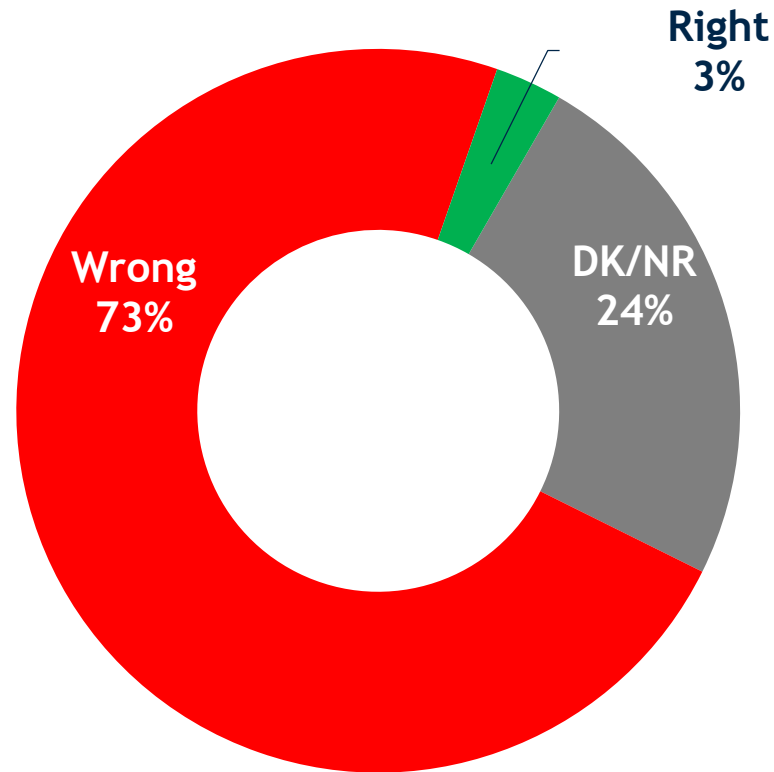
In current situation, do you think decision of Molana Fazal Rehman's Azadi March is right or wrong decision to protest?

Of the people who are [46%] **satisfied** with the performance of current PTI's government have majority negative response on Azadi March.

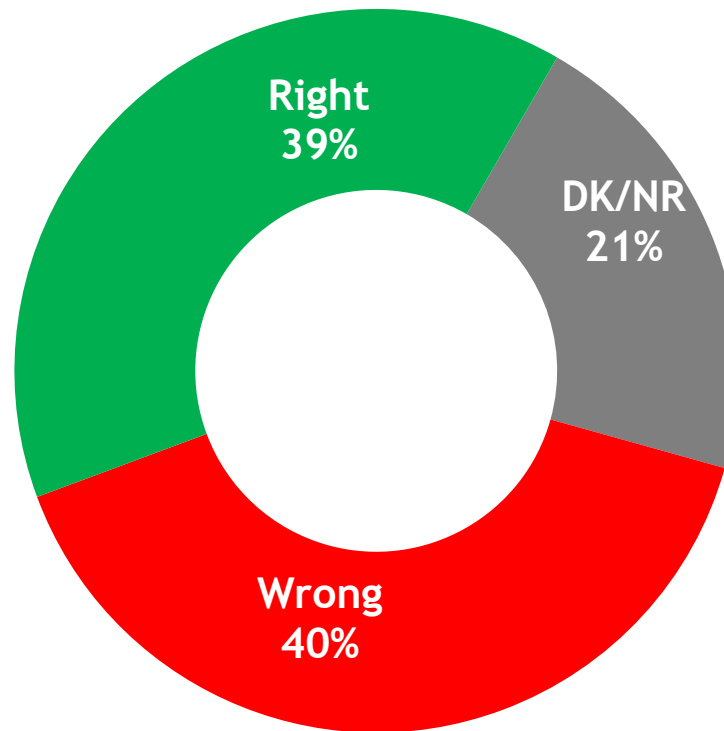

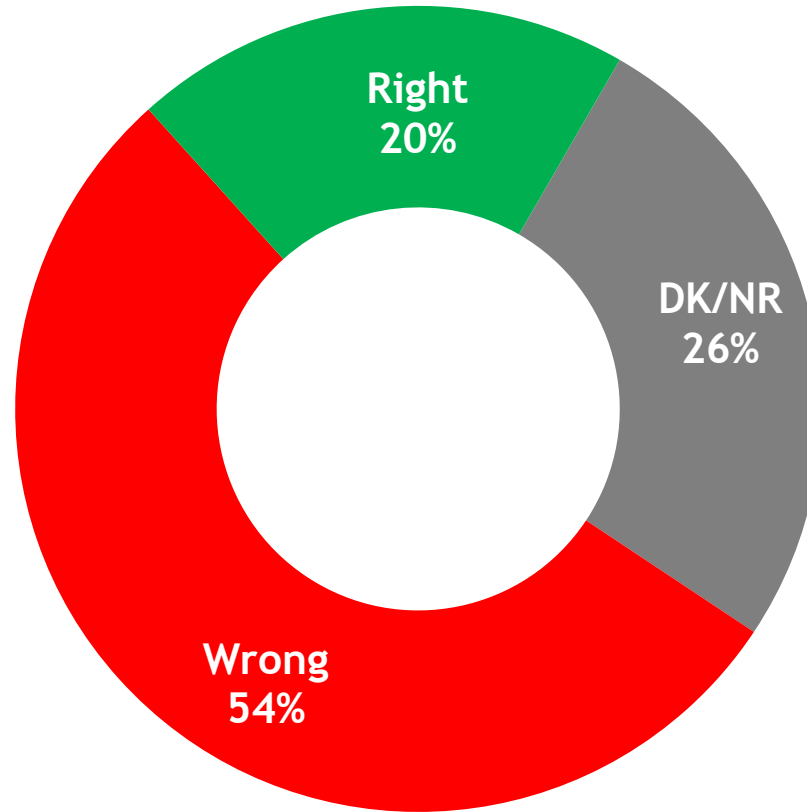
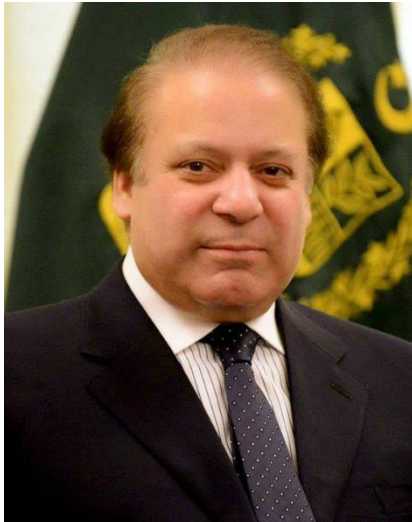
# In current situation, do you think decision of Molana Fazal Rehman's Azadi March is right or wrong decision to protest?

Of the people who are [50%] **not satisfied** with the performance of current PTI's government have divided opinion on Azadi March.



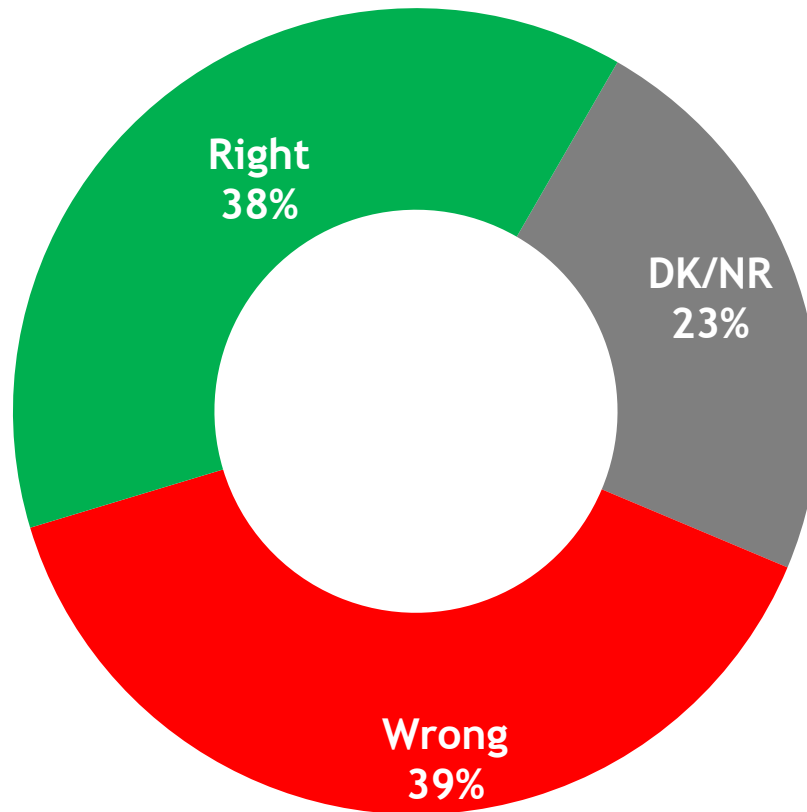
Nawaz Shareef has decided to support Mulana Fazal ur Rahman's protest, do you think this was the right decision?

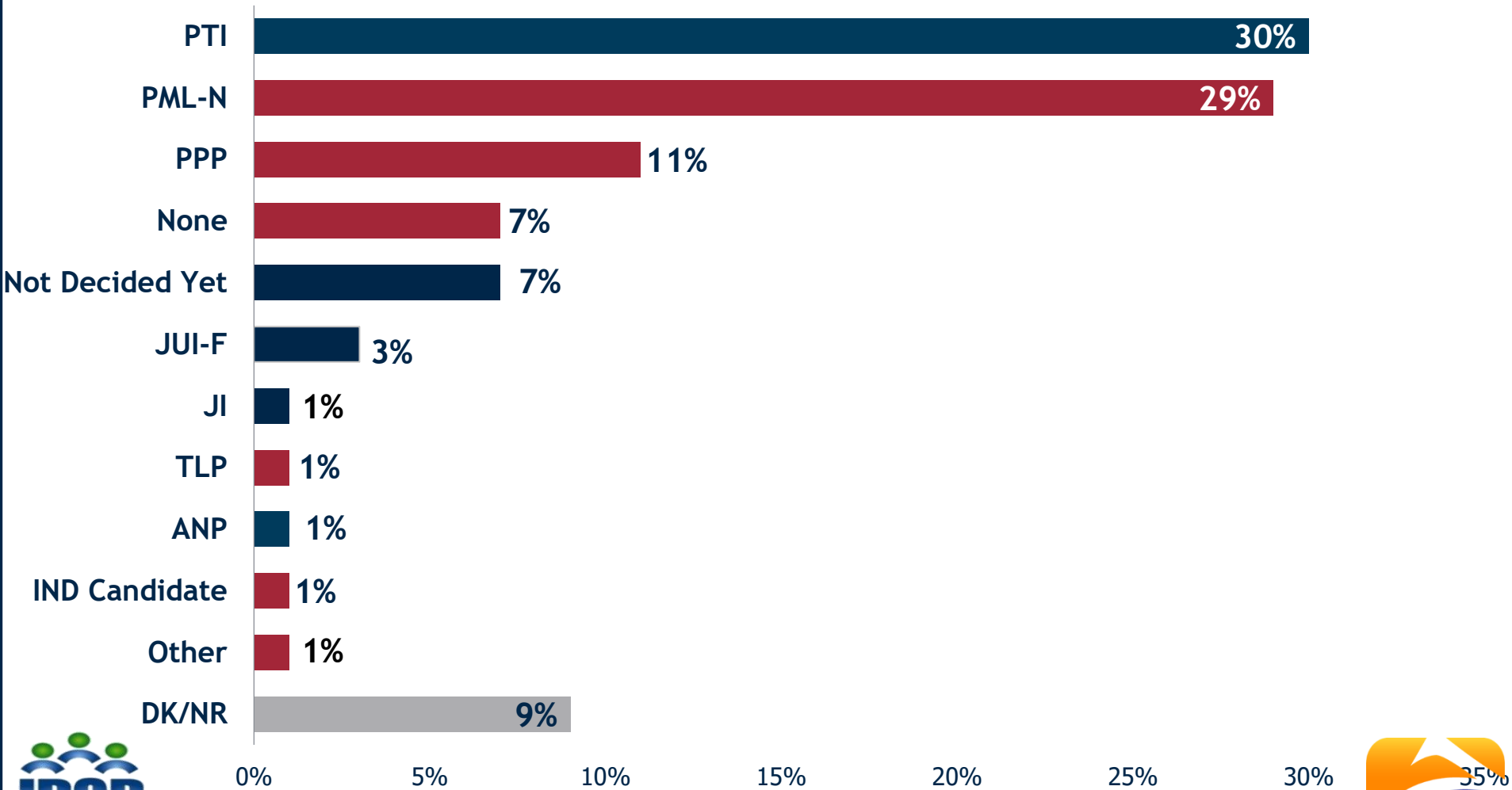


# Nawaz Shareef has decided to support Mulana Fazal ur Rahman's protest, do you think this was the right decision?
